

## **1. When does enrollment begin for Fall 2021?**

Community registration begins on March 1, 2021.

\*Due to Covid-19 restrictions this year, registration drop off will be different. For current students, forms need to be placed in your child's backpack, mailed in, or handed to a teacher. For community enrollment, forms need to be mailed in, or dropped off at the PUMC Preschool entryway beginning March 1, 2021. We will need a copy of the child's birth certificate and immunization records as well. If mailing in form, please use this address:

## **2. May I tour the preschool?**

## **3. How do I register for class?**

Registration is easy! Just fill out the registration form that is available on the website or pick up in the preschool entryway. A non-refundable registration fee of \$90.00 (beginner class), \$100 (Pre-K) or \$115 (Pre-K- M-F) is required to reserve your place in the program. If you are enrolling a second child, please fill out a separate enrollment form for each child. If classes are full, children are placed on a waiting list and called when an opening becomes available. If you are waitlisted, you do not have to pay the enrollment fee until an opening is available.

## **4. What other documents are needed for registration?**

You will need to turn in registration form, copy of birth certificate and immunization records if your child is a new student to PUMC Preschool. If your child is returning, then he/she will only need immunization records if shots have been updated.

**5. How much is tuition?**

Tuition costs are on our registration form. Tuition is prorated and broken down into 10 monthly payments (Aug - May). Payments are made online each month.

**6. Do we have before/after school care?**

No, we do not have before or after school care.

**7. Does my child have to be potty trained to attend school?**

Yes, all students need to be independent in the restroom and be toilet trained.

**8. Do the students eat lunch at school?**

Pre-K students do eat lunch at school. Students need to bring their own lunch with drink and cold pack as needed.

**9. Do the students eat snacks at school?**

Students in our beginners class do eat a snack. Students take turns providing drinks, paper towels, and snacks for their classmates.

**10. What time can I bring my child to school?**

Staff begin greeting students at their cars at 8:45 each morning.

**11. What time can I pick up my child from school?**

Beginner classes are dismissed at 11:30. Pre-K classes are dismissed at 1:00.

**12. What curriculum does the preschool use?**

We use a variety of materials that are standard and themed based. We also use Heggerty Phonics and Everyday Math.

**13. When does school start?**

Our first school day is August 9, 2021 with our last day of school being May 20,2022. We follow Northwest Hendricks County School Corporation's school calendar.
